## **2025 Program Evaluation Topic Selection Process Proposals**

The Legislative Audit Commission has typically directed the Office of the Legislative Auditor (OLA) to complete five to six mid- to large-scope program evaluations per year. The Commission selects these topics near the end of a legislative session, and OLA typically releases the evaluations late winter the following year. This cycle has some disadvantages, including that evaluations are often released mid-session, which can make acting quickly on recommendations difficult, efforts to most efficiently staff evaluations are complicated, and evaluations often cannot begin until well after issues are identified. The table below suggests changes to the typical topic selection cycle. If one of the proposed changes below is adopted, we recommend trying it for a period of two years and evaluating whether it is responsive to legislative needs.
