



- Generally did not comply with significant finance-related legal requirements
- Generally did not have adequate internal controls
- Total of 11 findings

Insufficient Monitoring of Federal Money for Hazardous Materials Training

Results

- Insufficient documentation for reimbursements
- No other monitoring

Contributing Factor

MBFTE was not aware of the requirements

Recommendations

- MBFTE should strengthen internal controls over federal training reimbursements to ensure appropriate monitoring is performed.
- MBFTE should conduct required monitoring over federal awards



State of Minnesota

No Oversight of Aid Issued to Four Statewide **Fire Organizations**

Result

\$4,239,000 in reimbursements paid with none questioned

Contributing Factors

- Vague criteria in place for necessary oversight
- No agreements in place between MBFTE and organizations to provide authority



State of Minnesota

Recommendations

- MBFTE should seek guidance from the Legislature and DPS regarding what oversight it should provide of the aid issued to Minnesota Firefighter Initiative, Minnesota Air Rescue Team, Arrowhead Regional Urban Search and Rescue, and Task Force 1.
- MBFTE should work with the Legislature and DPS to determine if they need additional authority to oversee the aid issued to Minnesota Firefighter Initiative, Minnesota Air Rescue Team, Arrowhead Regional Urban Search and Rescue, and Task Force 1.

Result

 The same employee collected, deposited, and recorded check deposits.

Contributing Factor

• MBFTE was not aware of the requirements.

Recommendation


 MBFTE should comply with state policy to adequately separate duties involved in collecting and depositing receipts.
